Sacramental Preparation Program - First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion

Per diocesan policy, two years of preparation are required to receive the sacraments of Reconciliation and Communion - 1st and 2nd grade. Children will receive their First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion during their 2nd grade. *Parents of children making their First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion will be **required²** to attend four (4) Mandatory Meetings throughout the year. Children will be **required²** to attend two (2) Mandatory workshops throughout the year.*

Special Sacrament: Baptism, First Reconciliation, and First Holy Communion
