Sacramental Preparation Program – Confirmation

Per diocesan policy, two full years are required to receive the sacrament of Confirmation – Currently 7th & 8th Grade. Please see the Confirmation Guidelines for other requirements. For Fall Confirmation, Candidates must also register and attend ALL Classes from September until Confirmation Day and then continue with the High School program taught on Thursday. A parent must attend the required parent's meeting².
